Celebrating CARICOM's Golden Jubilee: An Examination of the Roles of Central and Export-Import Banks

On the 28th of September 2023, Dr. Kevin Greenidge, Governor of the Central Bank of Barbados, delivered the third Distinguished Owen S. Arthur Memorial (DOSAM) Lecture.

Organized by the University of the West Indies' Shridath Ramphal Centre (SRC) for International Trade Law, Policy and Services in collaboration with the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB), the topic of this year's lecture was "Celebrating CARICOM's Golden Jubilee: An Examination of the Roles of Central and Export-Import Bank."

The lecture was attended by several specially invited guests including Mrs. Arthur, Members of Parliament, and Professor Clive Landis, Pro Vice-Chancellor & Principal of the University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus.

In his lecture, Dr. Greenidge outlined his ideal framework for sustainable inclusive growth in the Caribbean which he defined as growth which enhances the quality of life of the entire population of Caribbean people across generations without destroying the environment.
